



ISDF 2027 is expecting to welcome 1,000 - 1,300 healthcare participants from the various diabetic foot care fields and 150 - 250 industry delegates.


Top 20 Countries


Participant Distribution by Region

New in 2027

Increased Focus on the Success of Industry Symposia

The satellite symposia will be scheduled outside of the scientific programme to improve attendance. To achieve that, participants will be able to attend symposia **during** their **lunch break**. Half an hour will be set aside for lunch at the start of the lunch break, after which the symposia will start. There will be a maximum of 3 satellite symposia running in parallel in rooms of different capacity (300 pax, 200 pax and 80 pax).

The ISDF 2027 will ensure that the number and capacity of the symposia is proportional to the expected number of participants so that each symposium has a realistic opportunity to fill the room. The Conference Organiser will **intensify the promotion** of the symposia and will encourage companies to use their channel to promote their symposium. We are happy to facilitate feedback from the Scientific Committee regarding the **topics and speakers** and will strive not to schedule symposia covering the same topic at the same time.

Exhibition Space Spread Out in High-Traffic Areas

In 2027, the exhibition zones will concentrate around high-traffic areas, such as catering, posters, and scientific sessions, and will be divided between the ground floor and 1st floor. This optimises the space of the venue, ensures a better flow of participants around the different exhibition stands and increases the overall engagement of attendees. A less cramped layout will benefit all exhibitors and will improve brand visibility.

Opportunity for Product Placement in Workshops (5,000 EUR)

ISDF 2027 offers you the opportunity to feature one of your products (product placement) in the hands-on workshops (part of scientific programme) in the afternoon. The scientific content and running of the workshops remain the responsibility of the Symposium. Companies will provide the product depending on the workshop topic (NPWT, offloading, advanced wound care, etc.) and are welcome to have their representatives in the room to answer questions from the audience.

Workshops represent a great opportunity for your company to **showcase your technical expertise and products**. These provide significant value to attendees, increase their engagement, maximise brand visibility and generate valuable leads. We will announce the workshop topics during 2026 and are happy to receive suggestions.

Terms & Conditions

The terms & conditions of exhibiting are included in this prospectus. Please note that signing the Booking Form indicates acceptance of these terms & conditions. The Booking Form will be held as a valid liable contract, by which both parties will be bound.

When submitting this Booking Form, you confirm that you are aware of the following conditions:

1. All company representatives must be registered, check in at the registration desk and wear name badges at all times.
2. Payment terms: Full payment is due within 14 days of signing the agreement. To ensure participation and inclusion in printed materials, payment must be received no later than 30 days before the conference. Should the Supporter fail to complete payments in due time, the Conference Organiser will be entitled to cancel the reservation while cancellation will be subject to cancellation fees as determined below.
3. Cancellation policy: The agreement is binding upon order confirmation. For cancellations made before the 1st of September 2026, 25% of the total fee is non-refundable, and 75% will be refunded. Cancellations after the 1st of September 2026 are non-refundable, and the full fee remains payable. This applies regardless of withdrawal or non-participation.
4. Force majeure: The performance of the specified agreement by ISDF 2027 is subject to the following events that are beyond the reasonable control of ISDF 2027, including but not limited to: 1. War, including armed conflict 2. Strikes or labour disputes at the event venue 3. Government regulations 4. Disaster, fire 5. Infectious disease epidemics and pandemics 6. Terrorism or threats of terrorism 7. Curtailment of transportation facilities.
5. Should any of the above prevent or unreasonably delay at least 25% of the expected ISDF 2027 attendees from participating at the event, making it inadvisable, illegal, impossible, or commercially impractical to hold ISDF 2027 or to fully perform the terms of the agreement, the agreement may be terminated without penalty and with performance fully excused for any one or more of these reasons by written notice from the Conference Organiser to the company. We will endeavor to refund as much of the received fees as possible. However, ISDF 2027 reserves the right to deduct the already incurred costs of the conference before such refund. The remaining funds will be allocated proportionately among the sponsors and exhibitors.
6. Upon signature, your company contact and invoice details will be saved in our CRM system for communication and marketing purposes.
